








In the noble journey of education, the year 1998 marked a defining milestone—the birth of **DAV International School, Amritsar**. What began as a small sapling has now grown into a mighty banyan tree, deeply rooted in values and ever-expanding through knowledge, creativity and innovation. Over the years, the school has become a trusted name in education, nurturing young minds with dedication, vision and purpose.

Affiliated with the **Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE)**, New Delhi, the school offers a complete continuum of learning from **Nursery** to **Grade XII**. It stands on the timeless ideals of **Swami Dayanand Saraswati Ji** and **Mahatma Hansraj Ji**, harmonising modern education with enduring Indian values. With the steadfast support of its management, administrators and teachers, the institution has grown into a vibrant centre of holistic learning. The **lush green campus** provides an environment where education flows as naturally as life itself, balancing tradition with innovation.

Today, spread across **8.6 acres**, the school proudly nurtures **more than 4,300 students** under the guidance of **179 dedicated teachers**. The campus houses the **Kids Kingdom**, a lively **primary block** with fully air-conditioned smart classrooms, 2 computer labs, a music and dance room, 2 activity areas, and a cheerful **Fun and Frolic Zone**. The **Mahatma Anand Swami Block** for senior students is enriched with modern infrastructure, including air-conditioned smart classrooms, 10 specialised laboratories, a well-stocked resource centre, an art studio, music and dance rooms, a yajnashala, a cafeteria, a guest house, ample parking space and a 150-kilowatt solar panel. The campus is also equipped with

three performance stages—Stage 1 in the Kids Kingdom for junior students, Stage 2 in the ground area, and Stage 3 adjoining the skating rink—providing platforms for students to showcase their talent and creativity. Adding to this, the **Umang Block** serves as a beacon of service, extending **free education and vocational training to underprivileged children**. The school also ensures the safety of every child through its **three-gate entry system** and a **well-defined transportation policy** that makes commuting safe and efficient.

To further strengthen its foundation, the school is on the verge of completing 3 significant projects—an **expansive Auditorium** with a large seating capacity, new **Yajnashala** and a **state-of-the-art Sound Recording Studio**.

The relentless pursuit of excellence has brought the school numerous recognitions at both national and international levels. Among its accolades are the **Mahatma Hansraj Award** and the **CBSE Teachers' Award** conferred upon the Principal, the **CBSE National School Sanitation Award**, the **Swachh Vidyalaya Puraskar** by the State Government and the prestigious **International School Award** by the British Council. The Pre-Primary years mark a child's first step outside the comfort of home, and at DAV International School, Amritsar, this transition is made joyful and secure. Located in the Junior Building Kids' Kingdom, the wing offers

Air-conditioned Smart Classrooms and a warm, home-like environment. Bright activity areas, **slides, swings and a toy train** ensure that learning blends naturally with play. Our trained and experienced staff nurture children with patience and care, focusing on healthy growth, happy learning and confidence building. Special emphasis is placed on English communication skills, while Hindi is gently introduced from Lower Kindergarten to strengthen language development. A wide range of play-based and creative activities foster social, emotional, cognitive and motor skills.

The assessment pattern is continuous and comprehensive, carried out on a daily basis to capture the overall growth of each child, covering listening, speaking, reading, writing, interpersonal skills and active participation. The academic session is divided into three terms for ongoing observation and support. Storytelling, an integral part of the learning process, truly reflects the child's ability to imagine, connect and express with confidence. A distinctive feature of the Pre-Primary Wing is the theme-based Annual Function with 100% participation, boosting stage confidence and self-expression.

Each classroom is air-conditioned, equipped with smart boards, and supported by class libraries and e-learning resources.

Other learning spaces include an ICT lab, Activity Zones and dedicated rooms for music and dance, encouraging creativity and expression. The teaching approach is experiential and interactive, supported by notebook work, guided reading and art-integrated activities that foster confidence and independent thinking. THE RISING STARS

(Grades VI-VIII)

The Middle Wing of DAV International School, comprising Grades VI to VIII, is located in the Senior Building. The spacious, well-ventilated, **air-conditioned classrooms** are equipped with **smart boards for interactive learning**. A variety of laboratories—Social Science, Mathematics, Composite Science and IT Lab—along with a well-stocked library, provide a stimulating academic environment. Students also have full access to the Atal Tinkering Lab, fostering innovation, creativity and hands-on exploration.

The assessment system is progressive, combining Periodic Tests, Term Examinations and Project-Based Learning. For Grade VIII, the session concludes with the DAV Examination, preparing students for higher classes. Skill-based education introduces creative, traditional and modern fields that enhance imagination and practical ability. At the middle level (Grades VI to VIII), one skill module of 12 to 15 hours' duration is offered to students to provide vocational exposure at an early age.

Students of Grades VI & VII are offered participation in Scouts and Guides and students of Grade VIII are offered NCC Junior Wing for nurturing discipline and leadership. Regular sports and morning activity sessions further support their overall growth. The Middle Stage thus offers a balanced environment where scholastic learning, co-scholastic activities and value-based education together shape confident, well-rounded individuals.

THE SHINING SCHOLARS (Grades IX-X)

The Secondary Wing of DAV International School provides a stimulating environment with **air-conditioned smart classrooms** and experienced faculty. A balanced blend of academic and co-curricular engagements like debates, cultural festivals, environmental campaigns, literary pursuits and interdisciplinary exhibitions, encourages students to think critically, express creatively and collaborate meaningfully.



Air-conditioned Smart Classroom

Academic progress is monitored through class tests, oral assessments, MCQs, periodic tests, assignments, and ALS activities, while two term examinations and pre-boards ensure thorough preparation for the final board exams. Attendance in all exams is compulsory, with a minimum of **75% attendance** required as per CBSE norms.

Specialized laboratories, including Composite Science, IT, Mathematics, Social Science and the Atal Tinkering Lab, provide students with practical exposure, promoting hands-on learning and innovation. The practical classes and examinations in various subjects allow students to apply their knowledge in real-life contexts. Beyond academics, the National Cadet Corps (NCC) Junior Wing, open to both boys and girls, further fosters discipline and leadership.

It is important to note that **No direct or local admissions are offered in Grade X**; only transfer cases are considered. For students in Grades IX and X, apart from the five main subjects, they may opt for a sixth skill-based subject, choosing from Information Technology, Artificial Intelligence, or Beauty and Wellness. Additionally, students can select a seventh subject from the languages, as prescribed by CBSE, if they wish.

(Grades XI-XII)

The Senior Secondary stage at DAV International School marks the culmination of years of learning into maturity and excellence. Students step into this phase prepared to become thoughtful individuals with vision and purpose. Guided by **experienced mentors** in **smart classrooms**, learners explore **diverse disciplines** and participate in leadership conclaves, intellectual symposiums, student-led conferences, entrepreneurial showcases and cultural and literary activities. Global collaborations and academic exchange programmes further broaden their outlook, while **modern laboratories**, digital platforms and experiential learning spaces strengthen conceptual mastery and application.


Community service and leadership are fostered through the Interact Club (supported by Rotary Club 3070) and the Senior Student Council, which bridges the school's vision with the student body. Career awareness sessions, mentoring programmes and close coordination with families help every learner chart a clear pathway. In alignment with CBSE norms, a minimum of **75% attendance** is mandatory and students are expected to maintain academic integrity in all assessments.

The Investiture, Farewell and Freshers' Ceremonies are among the most awaited events for senior students, while the Blessings Day for Grade XII holds special significance as students seek the grace of the Almighty for success in their board examinations.

Student learning is tracked through viva and practical examinations, competency-based MCQs, assignments, periodic evaluations and ALS activities. In addition, two term exams along with pre-board examinations, are conducted to prepare students thoroughly for the final board assessment. Overall pass percentage for both XI and XII is 33% marks. **Students must secure a minimum of 33% marks separately in both the theory and practical components of each subject to pass the examination.**



School Uniform

As per the directives of DAV CMC, New Delhi, all DAV Schools across India follow the same school uniform. The school does not recommend any specific shop for purchase; parents are free to buy the existing uniform of the specified brand (Material) from any shop of their choice.

As per the directives received from DAV CMC, New Delhi, the revised common uniforms will be implemented in every DAV Public/Model School. The duration for switching over to the new uniforms is three years, and the school will implement the change in a phased manner:

- Phase I (2026-27): Introducing New Uniform in Grades Nursery to II
- Phase II (2027-28): Introducing New Uniform in Grades III to VIII
- Phase III (2028-29): Introducing New Uniform in Grades IX to XII






The school nurtures life skills through a wide range of sports, including Table Tennis, Karate, Yoga, Wushu, Shooting, Roller Skating, Badminton, Athletics, Taekwondo, Jump Rope, Gymnastics, Chess, Judo, Aerobics, Hockey, Cricket, Kho-Kho, Football, Lawn Tennis, Basketball, Volleyball, etc. With a well-developed sports infrastructure and an indoor stadium, students get ample opportunities to excel. In recognition of sporting excellence, the school has received the CBSE Sports Promotion Award, while its students have earned the National Child Award for Exceptional Achievement, the CBSE Chacha Nehru Sports Award and various scholarships.



Elevating Pedagogical Excellence

At DAV International School, Amritsar, the teaching fraternity continually hones its skills through In-Service and Capacity-Building Programmes conducted by the DAV Centre for Academic Excellence, DAV CMC, New Delhi and CBSE. These programmes ensure that our educators remain aligned with the latest educational practices while fulfilling the 50 hours of compulsory training prescribed by CBSE. With every session, teachers refine their methodologies, enrich their perspectives and enhance their classroom teaching.



Pathway to Admission

The eligibility criterion for various grades is based on the child's age. For the next academic year, the applicant's age as of 31st March 2026, as recorded in the birth certificate, will determine the eligibility for admission to a particular grade.

Recommended age criteria for admission

Grade	Age Criteria
Nursery	3 – 4 years (3 years as on March 31, 2026)
LKG	4 – 5 years (4 years as on March 31, 2026)
UKG	5 – 6 years (5 years as on March 31, 2026)
I	6 – 7 years (6 years as on March 31, 2026)
II	7 – 8 years (7 years as on March 31, 2026)



Registration Procedure

- Procure a copy of the school prospectus from the school.
- Fill in the registration form and submit it along with the required documents mentioned therein.
- The date and time of interaction with the Principal will be communicated by the school office at the time of submission of the registration form.
- Both parents must be present along with the child at the time of interaction.



Admission Procedure

- Admission to Grade I onwards is subject to the availability of seats.
- **No direct admissions are granted in Grades X and XII.** Only transfer cases from CBSE-affiliated schools will be considered, subject to seat availability
- Failure to pay the admission fee by the due date will lead to forfeiture of the seat, which will then be offered to the next shortlisted candidate.
- Registration and admission fees are non-refundable.
- Mid-term admissions are not entertained, except in transfer cases where seats are available.
- Any change of address must be intimated to the school promptly.



Grade-wise Criteria

- Pre-Nursery to UKG – Admission is based on an interaction/interview with the child.
- Grades I & II – Written test in English, Mathematics and EVS.
- Grade III – Written test in English, Mathematics, EVS, Punjabi and Hindi (languages depending on subjects studied in the previous school).
- Grades IV – IX – Written test in English, Punjabi, Hindi, Mathematics, Science and Social Science



Grade XI

- Provisional admission is granted on the basis of the Written Test and Grade X Pre-Board results.
- Regular admission is confirmed only after the Grade X CBSE result is declared and the candidate fulfills the conditions laid down by the school.

Important Instructions Regarding Fee Payment:

- No cash payments are accepted.
- Fees can be paid online through any bank's Debit/Credit Card or Net Banking (without transaction charges) via the school website: www.davintschool.org, using the Student Admission Number as the School ID and Password.
- Fees can also be paid through swipe (card) option, bank transfer, cheque, demand draft, or pay order in favor of DAV International School, Amritsar. Only CTS cheques will be accepted.
- For each child, a separate cheque must be issued. Please write the Student's Name, Class, Section, Father's/Mother's Name, Phone Number, and Admission Number on the back of the cheque.
- Receipt of the cheque will be subject to clearance by the bank.

Transportation Policy

The school does not own any transport. The parents are responsible for making arrangement of transport for their wards. A private vehicle can be hired by contacting the private vehicle operators, keeping in mind the "Safe School Vahan Scheme" of the government specially implemented for the safety of school children. The school authorities are very strict with regard to the implementation of the above said scheme and have even banned defaulting transporters. The parents must submit a written undertaking in the school office stating that they have assured the safety of the vehicles hired by them under the Safe School Vahan Policy. Also, in case of emergency, parents should come on their own to pick and drop their children. The school will not send the child with any guardian, relative or friend.

Use of Personal Vehicles by Students

- No student up to Grade X is permitted to commute independently on a personal vehicle.

Students of Grades XI and XII may use a two-wheeler only under the following conditions:

- The two-wheeler must not exceed an engine capacity of 50CC.
 - The student must hold a valid learner's license issued by the RTO.
 - Students aged 16-18 years applying for a learner's license must provide written consent from parents/guardians.
 - Riding heavyweight or racing bikes is strictly prohibited. Any student found violating this rule will be denied entry to the school premises.
 - Wearing of helmets is compulsory for both the rider and the pillion rider at all times.
 - Students are strictly prohibited from driving four-wheelers to school under any circumstances.
- Any violation of these rules will result in the immediate cancellation of the student's permission to commute independently.
