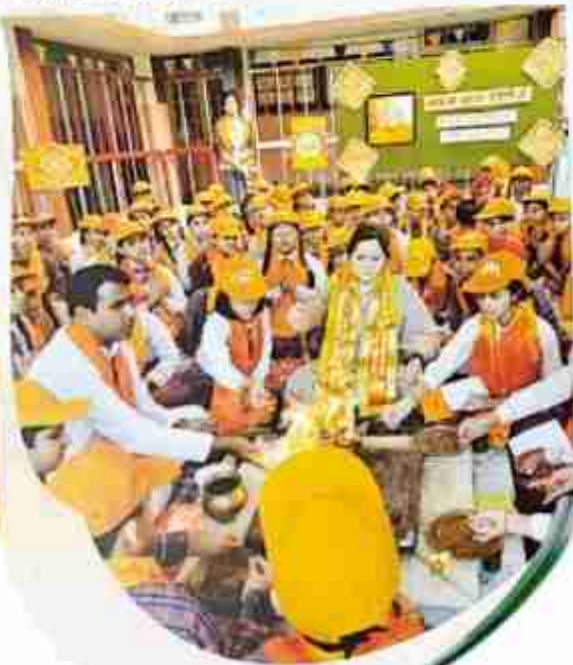
Fostering Courageous Hearts **NCC ARMY WING** (JUNIOR AND SENIOR)

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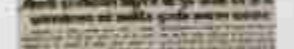

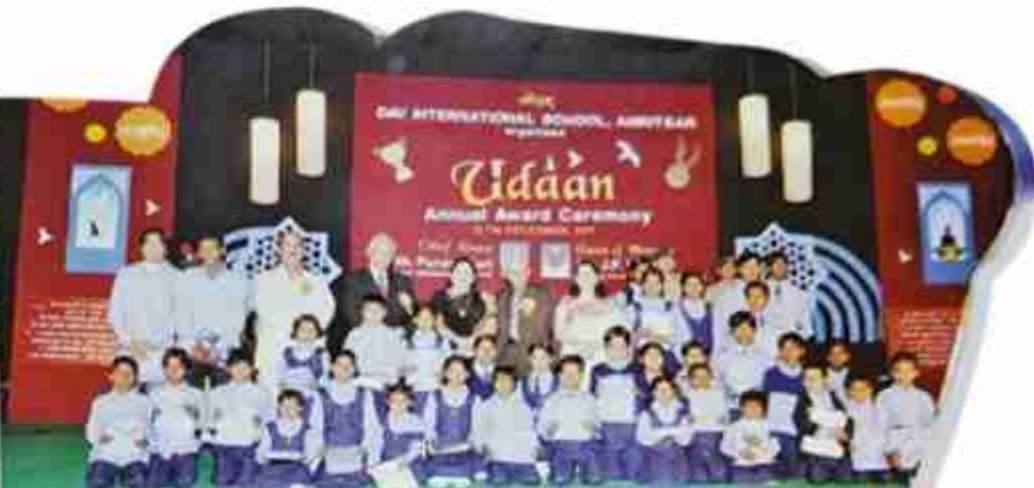

THE SCHOOL DIPLOMATIC CODE

For Students:

- Reach the school on time.
- Bring your books and copies as per the time-table.
- Bring the required stationary, tiffin and water bottles from home.
- Attend the classes regularly.
- Be respectful towards the teachers
- Don't roam aimlessly in the corridors.
- Take care of the school property.
- Complete the copy work, assignments and other project works timely.
- Don't bring mobile phone or any other electronic device in the school.
- Don't carry too much of cash in school.
- Go to the canteen only on the allotted canteen day.
- Don't use abusive language.

For Parents:

- Don't indulge in any fights or arguments, contact the class teacher in case of a trouble with any student.
 - Try to converse in English with the teachers or fellow students.
 - Participate in extra-curricular activities.
- Check the child's school diary regularly.
 - Keep track of the messages updated in the class WhatsApp group.
 - Converse with the child in English, as much as possible.
 - Attend all the PT Meets on regular basis to know about the child's progress.
 - Pay the school fee timely.
 - Adhere to the school protocol strictly.



ADMISSION MODALITIES

1. Admission for class I onwards will be done as per availability of seats.
2. No admission in classes 10th and 12th.
3. The final decision regarding admission rests with the Principal.
4. Failure to pay the admission fee by due date will entail forfeiture of seat and the same will go to the next shortlisted candidate.
5. Dues once deposited will not be refunded.
6. In XI, provisional admission is granted on the basis of student's performance in class X Pre-Board result. It does not guarantee

regular admission in class XI. Regular admission is made only after the declaration of class X Board result, fulfilling the conditions laid by the school.

7. Mid-term admission is not accepted, except in transfer cases and that too if there is a seat.
8. Registration fee is not refundable.
9. Change of address must be intimated to the school as and when it takes place.

Important Instructions Regarding Fee Payment:

- The school does not take any additional charges except the quarterly fee.
- Fee can be paid ONLINE by any Bank's Debit/Credit Card or Net Banking (without any transaction charges) on school website : www.davintschool.org. Student **ADMISSION NUMBER** is the **School ID and Password**.
- The payment can be done by **Swipe** option as well.
- Payment should be made by **CHEQUE/DD/PAY ORDER** only in favour of **DAV INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL, AMRITSAR**.
- Do write Student's Name, Class, Section, Father's/Mother's Name, Phone No. and Admission No. at the back of the Cheque.
- Give Separate Cheque for each child.
- Don't give post-dated Cheques.
- Give only CTS Cheques.
- Receipt of Cheque will be subject to the clearance by the Bank.
- Non-Receipt of fee circular will not be considered as a reason for non-payment of fees in time.
- No student will be permitted to appear in the examination without fee clearance.
- If any child fails to pay the fees for two consecutive terms, his/her name will be struck off and the child will be declared ineligible to continue his/her studies. He/she can be re-admitted after paying the full admission fee, provided there is a vacant seat.

How to Apply Registration Procedure

- Procure your copy of the school prospectus.
- Fill the registration form and submit it along with the documents mentioned therein.
- The time of interaction with the Principal will be intimated to you by the school office at the time of submission of registration form.
- Both the parents must be present along with the child at the time of interaction.



ASSESSMENT AND EVALUATION

Grades - II

Children are assessed on the basis of their class performance which covers listening, speaking, reading, writing skills, interpersonal skills, team spirit and participation in class activities. The academic session is divided into 3 terms for 3 assessments.

VI - VII

6 terms are conducted in an academic year and each term consists of 2 pen-paper tests and internal assessment.

VI - IX - X

Annual examinations are conducted at the end of session covering the complete syllabus.

Exams for class X are conducted by CBSE New Delhi.

Exams for class IX are conducted as per the guidelines of CBSE.

Exams for class VIII are conducted by DAV Centre for Academic Excellence, New Delhi.

Students have to secure at least 33% marks in each subject.

Students need to clear both theory and practical exam separately.

Periodic assessment of each subject of 20 marks is bifurcated as:

- Periodic test
- Multiple assessment
- Portfolio
- Subject enrichment activities. It is mandatory for students to appear in all the unit tests terminal evaluations and the pre board.

MERIT-BASED CONCESSIONS

- On the basis of percentage of marks secured in Board Examination, fee concession is provided to the students.
- Special Fee Concession is also granted to the students who bring glory to the school in various sports and co-scholastic activities.

XI - XII

The final exam of Class XI is conducted by DAV Centre for Academic Excellence, New Delhi.

The final exam of class XII is conducted by CBSE, New Delhi.

Overall pass percentage for both XI and XII is 33% marks. Students need to clear both theory and practical exams with 33% marks in each subject.

In Class XI, as per CBSE guidelines, a student failing in one subject is considered as a compartment case and in two subjects is considered Fail.

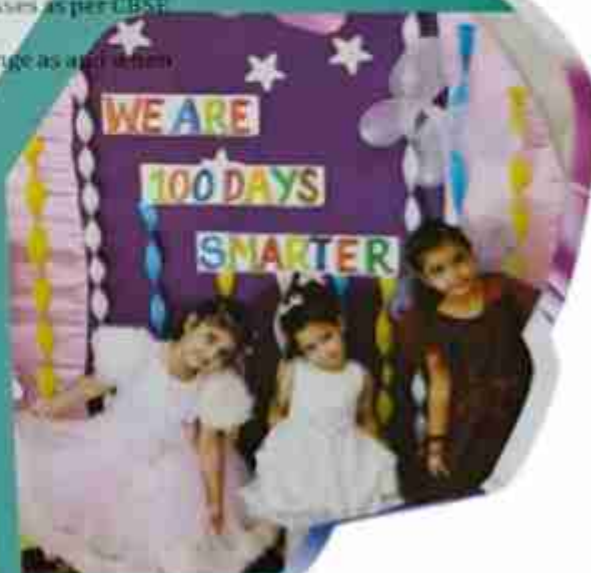
It is mandatory for the students to appear in all the unit assessments, terminal evaluations and the pre-board exams.

Please Note:

- Attendance in all the examinations and tests is compulsory.
- If a student is found using unfair means during any exam, he/she is liable to be expelled from the school.
- Defaulters on account of non-payment of school dues will not be allowed to appear in the examinations.
- No re-examination will be conducted in any subject.
- Minimum 75% attendance is required in all the classes as per CBSE norms.
- The curriculum of classes IX to XII is subject to change as and when CBSE guidelines are updated.

The SCHOLASTIC Domain

SAFETY & SECURITY

School Transportation

The school does not own any transport. The parents are responsible for making arrangement of transport for their wards. A private vehicle can be hired by contacting the private vehicle operators, keeping in mind the "Safe School Vahan Scheme" of the government specially implemented for the safety of school children. The school authorities are very strict with regard to the implementation of the above said scheme and have even banned defaulting transporters. The parents must submit a written undertaking in the school office stating that they have assured the safety of the vehicles hired by them under the Safe School Vahan Policy. Also, in case of emergency, parents should come on their own to pick and drop their children. The school will not send the child with any guardian, relative or friend.

Till class X no student is allowed to come independently on his or her own vehicle. Only the students of classes XI and XII can do so, but by keeping the following points in mind:-

- ❖ To get the Learner's License made
- ❖ Not to drive heavyweight or racing bikes
- ❖ To wear helmet compulsorily



SCHOOL UNIFORM

As per the directives of DAVCMC, New Delhi, DAV Schools, all over India, have the same school uniform. School does not recommend any specific shop to purchase the uniform and parents are free to buy it, of the specified brand (Matalal), from any shop of their choice.

Boys: Fawn-coloured shirt with checked border on shirt, checked shorts with gallace and a pocket, fawn-coloured socks with maroon stripes and brown shoes, maroon patka for Sikh boys.

I-VII:

Girls: Fawn-coloured shirt with checks on pleated sleeves with border, checked bow/neck-tie, belt, checked pleated skirt, fawn-coloured socks and brown shoes.

Boys: Checked half-sleeved shirt with piping on sleeves and pockets, checked neck-tie, fawn-coloured shorts/ trousers, fawn-coloured socks and brown shoes, maroon patka for Sikh boys.

IX-XII

Girls: Fawn-coloured kurta with checked border on neck and sleeves, checked salwar, checked waist coat with fawn-coloured piping, maroon socks and brown shoes.

Boys: Checked half-sleeved shirt with piping on sleeves and pockets, checked neck-tie, fawn-coloured full pants, maroon socks and brown shoes, maroon patka/turban for Sikh boys.

WINTER UNIFORM

Girls: Full-sleeved, fawn-coloured shirt with checked piping on cuffs, checked skirt, maroon stockings, maroon sweater, maroon blazer, maroon cap and brown shoes.

Boys: Full-sleeved, fawn-coloured shirt with checked piping on cuffs, checked trousers, maroon sweater, maroon socks with fawn stripes, brown shoes, maroon cap, maroon jacket or coat for boys and girls, both, maroon patka for Sikh boys.

I-VIII:

Girls: Fawn-coloured shirt with checked pleated skirt, checked bow/neck-tie, belt, maroon socks, maroon sweater, maroon blazer and brown shoes.

Boys: Checked full-sleeved shirt, fawn-coloured trousers with checked neck-tie, belt, maroon socks, maroon sweater, maroon blazer and brown shoes, maroon patka for Sikh boys.

IX-XII

Girls: Fawn-coloured kurta with checked border on neck and sleeves, checked salwar, checked waist coat with fawn-coloured piping, maroon socks, maroon sweater, maroon blazer and brown shoes.

Boys: Checked full-sleeved shirt with piping on sleeves and pockets, checked neck-tie, fawn-coloured full pants, maroon socks, maroon sweater, maroon blazer and
