
- The final exam of Class XI is conducted by DAV Centre for Academic Excellence New Defty
- The final exam of class XII is conducted by CBSE, New Delhi.
- Overall pass percentage for both XI and XII is 33% marks. Students need to clear both theory and practical exams with 33% marks in each subject.
- In Class XI, as per CBSE guidelines, a student failing in one subject is considered as a compartment case and in two subjects in considered Fail.
- e It is mandatory for the students to appear in all the unit assessments, terminal evaluations and the pre-board exams.
